Application Deadline: April 15, 2010

Folds of Honor Foundation (FHF) provides post-secondary educational scholarships for children and spouses of military service men and women killed or disabled while serving our great nation. **Scholarships are to be used to subsidize the costs of tuition, school books, fees, room and board, special tools and equipment necessary for coursework, school-approved tutoring, and any other expense that the school in which the student is enrolled may deem appropriate and unmet.** Future-Use Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the applicant's school at time of enrollment.

Before completing this application, read the instructions and eligibility requirements carefully, and complete all items below. Incomplete applications will not be considered. If you are unable to provide the information requested, state the reason in the space provided, or attach a letter of explanation. **The applicant assumes responsibility for ensuring that all requested information is compiled as a complete packet and received no later than the designated deadline.**

- Proof of Dependency (i.e. Birth Certificate)**
- Photo of applicant with family and headshot of applicant**

- **Paragraph 1: Short Family Bio** (include your hometown and family activities)
- **Paragraph 2: Briefly describe the circumstances surrounding the service member's disability or death.**
- **Paragraph 3: What would this scholarship mean to your family and how will it help the applicant achieve future goals?**
